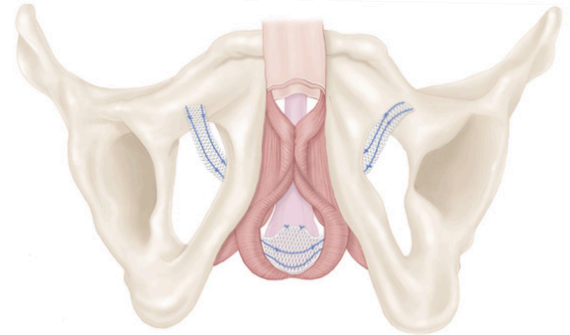


Male urinary incontinence

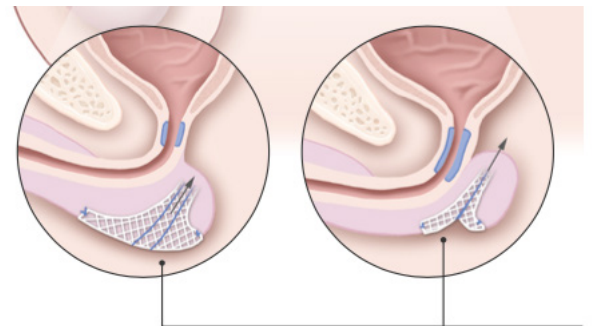


The Male Urethral Sling is a less-invasive treatment option

Treatment for urinary incontinence depends on different factors, such as the type of incontinence and how severe it is, age, symptoms, and overall health. One minimally invasive procedure, the **AdVance™ XP Male Sling System**, is here to help!

The male sling is a synthetic mesh-like surgical tape that is placed in the area of the urethra that is causing a problem. It acts as a "hammock," repositioning and supporting the urethra to help restore normal bladder control. The sling helps keep the urethra closed, especially when coughing, sneezing, and lifting and allows the patient more control over their bladder, reducing leaks.
